'Betting Sheets' supplied by Weatherbys.

By way of an update for Bookmakers regarding 'Betting Sheets', the following is an extract from a letter which most of you should have received personally. Weatherbys are happy to answer any queries regarding this issue.

"Weatherbys will be happy to continue providing 'Betting Sheets' for the foreseeable future.

We have considered the charges in some detail. This has not been an easy process with the lower quantities required, particularly at smaller meetings. We feel a charge of £6.45 (excl. VAT) per set is a reasonable one and workable for both parties.

We are in the process of setting up an on-line ordering system where sheets can be ordered up to two weeks in advance, and until midday the day before, of each race meeting and paid for by debit or credit card. This system will be found on <http://www.weatherbys.co.uk/bettingsheet> and will be available no later than Monday 1st October (hopefully a few days earlier than this) where you will be able to order sheets for all race meetings commencing from Monday 8th October onwards. We will be providing sheets free of charge at all racecourses up to and including 7th October. Any updates to this arrangement will be posted on the web page indicated above.

The above process is the easiest method of ordering. However, telephone orders for sheets can be made by calling 01933 440077 asking for 'Bookmaker Sheets'. This service will only be manned between the hours of 9.00am to 5.00pm Monday to Friday. Orders for Sunday and/or Monday racing will have to be made by 12 noon on Friday. A verbal debit/credit card transaction will take place to confirm your order.

The sheets will be delivered to the racecourse on the morning of racing, together with a list of Bookmakers who have ordered them. Whilst there may be slight variations in arrangements at each course, the intention is that the sheets can be collected from the 'badge box'.

We will be doing everything we can to ensure that the system runs smoothly. Any problems, please call Gary Mills on 01933 440077 or 07899 757504.
